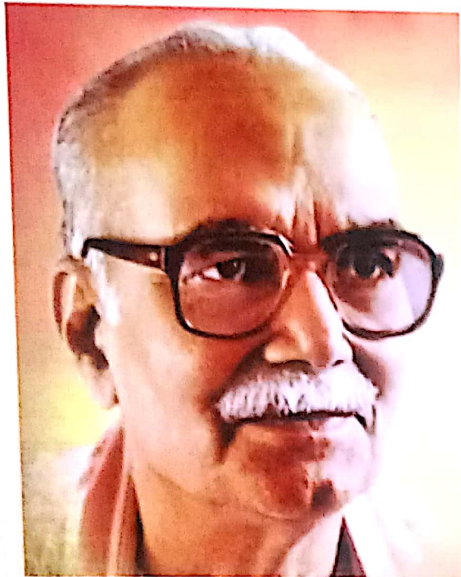

# Rajju Bhaiya



**P**rof. Rajendra Singh, popularly known as Rajju Bhaiya, was born on 29 Jan 1922 in village Banel, Tehsil Shikarpur, Dist. Bulandshahr of Uttar Pradesh. His father Shri Balbir Singh was the first Indian who got selected in Indian Engineering Services (IES). He was the Fourth Sarsanghchalak of RSS.

## Rajpal Singh Jan Kalyan Seva Samiti

**S**ome philanthropic and service oriented people of Bulandshahr took resolution of starting a Sainik School in memory of late Prof Rajju Bhaiya, the Fourth Sarsanghchalak of RSS. On this resolution, the first summoning was given by Ch Rajpal Singh, an Ex-Serviceman of vill Khandwaya (Shikarpur) by donating his entire agricultural land of 32 bighas (20225 sqm).

The said philanthropic and service oriented people formed the society under societies registration act-1960 and named this society as Rajpal Singh Jan Kalyan Seva Samiti.

The aim of the school is to prepare the cadets academically, physically, psychologically and spiritually for entry into National Defence Academy (NDA) and to become responsible citizens of India.

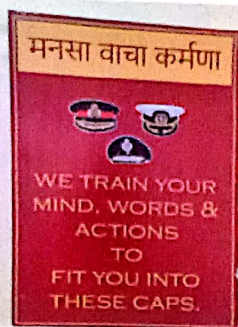
## OBJECTIVE

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The school is a residential institution for boys only. Admissions are made once a year in the month of April in class VI. The advertisement for the same is made in one of the national dailies of English and Hindi in the month of November. The candidates/their guardians have to get the registration done of the candidate, online, for the admission forms on payment of the registration fee which is Rs 2000/- The forms can be downloaded from the school website ([www.rbsvm.in](http://www.rbsvm.in)). The written entrance examination for selection of candidates is normally held on third Sunday in January each year. The qualified candidates in the entrance examination have to appear for a personal interview along with a medical fitness certificate from a Govt Hospital/Registered Medical Practitioner. The merit list is drawn based on the performance in entrance examination and interview. The candidates are called to the school for admission as per the merit list. A final medical examination is carried out by the Medical Officer of the school at campus and only medically fit candidates are admitted to the school.

The sons/wards of "Battle Casualties" are entitled to 5% of seats subject to obtaining minimum laid down percentage of marks in the written examination and have to pay only 50% of laid down fees. Similar benefits are provided to students hailing from North Eastern states (seven sisters), Laddakh and J&K.

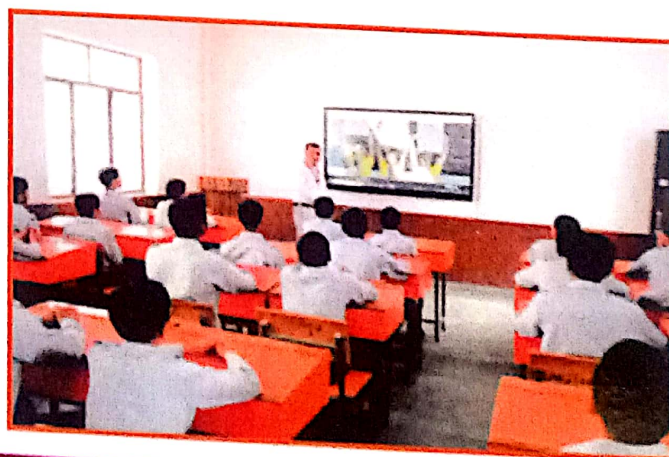
## CURRICULUM

## TRAINING

Apart from academic aspects, the cadets are subjected to the obligations of community living in the school. Physical fitness and holistic development of the cadets is one of the main focuses of the school. Regular PT, Games & Sports, Educational tours/trips, co-curricular and extra curricular activities are held throughout the stay of the cadets in the school. Cadets have to select and pursue one of the hobbies provided by the school. The school has adequate infrastructure for games and sports. Special emphasis is laid on tapping the creative potential of the cadets.

A modern Computer Lab with latest gadgetry including "Integrated White (IW) Board" is available in the school to ensure that the cadets remain abreast with the latest.

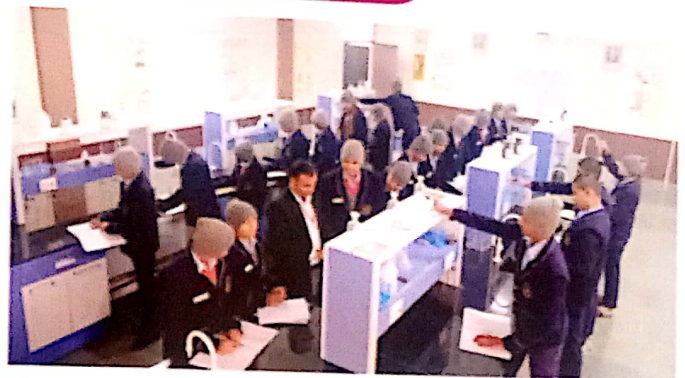


## LANGUAGE LAB

## LIBRARY

A well equipped library with adequate number of books, encyclopedia, magazines, periodicals, educational CDs, comics and e-library have been catered for to give ample opportunity to each cadet to cultivate the habit of reading and enhancing the knowledge. ## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES ▶▶

Enrichment of social and cultural habits ultimately shape a balanced personality in an individual when switching over from adolescence to adulthood. The school organizes programs by eminent artists under various agencies. Regular inter-house debate, declamation, essay writing and quiz competitions are also conducted during the academic year, in addition to various games and sports competitions.



## MESSING ▶▶▶▶▶

The school has a well furnished dining hall with a modernized kitchen. No cooking and serving utensils are of aluminium/plastic. There is potable drinking water for everyone in the school. The cadets are served only vegetarian meals. Non-vegetarian food is neither served nor allowed in the school premises. Adequate calories have been catered for in the menu as per the ICMR norms. Regular Dinner Nights are conducted to make cadets accustomed to mess etiquette. Month end Birthday Dinners are conducted to celebrate birthdays of cadets born in that month



## MEDICAL FACILITIES ▶▶▶▶▶

The school has a eight bedded infirmary with AC, a part time Medical Officer and a regular Nursing Assistant for treating minor ailments of the cadets and staff. Cases of serious illness are referred to the nearest empaneled/specialized hospital. Regular health checkups and periodic health camps are held throughout the year.

## HOUSES ▶▶▶▶▶

The freshers joining the school in class VI are accommodated in "Lav Kush" house. The rest are accommodated in Keshav, Madhav, Devras and Sudarshan houses. Each house has a House Master and a hostel superintendent except Lav Kush House which has a House Master and a lady Matron. The houses and the school have student appointments as well.



## FOSTER PARENTS ▶▶▶▶▶

The cadets hailing from far flung areas of North-East, Andaman & Nicobar, Lakshadweep, Daman & Diu, Laddakh, Rajouri and Poonch are provided with local foster parents who are allowed to visit the cadets and take care of them.

These are subject to revision/change. In addition to this, a sum of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) has to be deposited one time as security money, which is refundable.
